Direct Debit Request Service Agreement

Last updated July 2023

This is your Direct Debit Service Agreement with The Newsagents Association of NSW and Act Ltd, user ID 406-353 & ABN 13096737352. It explains what your obligations are when undertaking a Direct Debit arrangement with us. It also details what our obligations are to you as your Direct Debit provider.

Please keep this agreement for future reference. It forms part of the terms and conditions of your Direct Debit Request (DDR) and should be read in conjunction with your DDR authorisation.

Definitions	account means the account held at your financial institution from which we are authorised to arrange for		
	funds to be debited.		
	agreement means this Direct Debit Request Service Agreement between you and us.		
	<i>banking day</i> means a day other than a Saturday or a Sunday or a public holiday listed throughout Australia.		
	<i>debit day</i> means the day that payment by <i>you</i> to <i>us</i> is due.		
	debit payment means a particular transaction where a debit is made.		
	direct debit request means the Direct Debit Request between us and you.		
	<i>us</i> or <i>we</i> means The Newsagents Association of NSW and Act Ltd, (the Debit User) <i>you</i> have authorised by requesting a <i>Direct Debit Request</i> .		
	you means the customer who has signed or authorised by other means the Direct Debit Request.		
	<i>your financial institution</i> means the financial institution nominated by <i>you</i> on the DDR at which the <i>account</i> is maintained.		
1. Debiting your account	1.1 By signing a <i>Direct Debit Request</i> or by providing <i>us</i> with a valid instruction, <i>you</i> have authorised <i>us</i> to arrange for funds to be debited from <i>your account</i> . You should refer to the <i>Direct Debit Request</i> and this <i>agreement</i> for the terms of the arrangement between <i>us</i> and <i>you</i> .		
	1.2 We will only arrange for funds to be debited from <i>your account</i> as authorised in the <i>Direct Debit Request</i> .		
	or		
	We will only arrange for funds to be debited from <i>your account</i> if we have sent to the address nominated by <i>you</i> in the <i>Direct Debit Request</i> , a billing advice which specifies the amount payable by <i>you</i> to <i>us</i> and when it is due.		
	1.3 If the <i>debit day</i> falls on a day that is not a <i>banking day</i> , we may direct <i>your financial institution</i> to debit <i>your account</i> on the following <i>banking day</i> . If <i>you</i> are unsure about which day <i>your account</i> has or will be debited you should ask <i>your financial institution</i> .		
2. Amendments by us	2.1 We may vary any details of this agreement or a Direct Debit Request at any time by giving you at least fourteen (14) days written notice.		
3. Amendments by you	3.1 You may change*, stop or defer a debit payment, or terminate (cancel) this agreement at any time by providing us with at least 21 days notification by writing to:

	*Note: in relation to the above reference to 'change', your financial institution may change your debit payment only to the extent of advising us The Newsagents Association of NSW and Act Ltd of your new account details.		

4. Your obligations 4.1 It is your responsibility to ensure that there are sufficient clear funds available in your account to a debt payment to be made in accordance with the Direct Debt Request. 4.2 If there are insufficient clear funds in your account to meet a debt payment. a) you may be charged a fee and/or interest by your financial institution; b) you may also incur fees or charges imposed or incurred by us; and c) you must arrange for the debt payment to be made by another method or arrange for suffic clear funds to be in your account by an agreed time so that we can process the debit paym 4.3 You should check your account statement to verify that the amounts debited from your account correct. 5. Disputes 5.1 If you believe there has been an error in debiting your account, you should notify us directly on 1300 113 044 or nana@Nana.com.au and confirm that notice in writing with us as soon as poss so that we can resolve your query more quickly. Alternatively you can take it up directly with yoi financial institution. 5.2 If we conclude as a result of our investigations that your account has been incorrectly debite will respond to your query by parranging for your financial institution. 6.
